Several organizations and individuals in Bangladesh have continued to make contributions to the Embassy's Special Relief Account for the relief and rehabilitation of Nepal's earthquake victims. Today, Sanofi Bangladesh contributed a sum of BDT 19,12,850.00 (Bangladesh Taka Nineteen Lakhs Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty) to the Special Relief Fund today. Dr. Riad Mamun Prodhani, Managing Director of Sanofi, handed over a check of this amount to the Ambassador of Nepal His Excellency H.K. Shrestha amid a function at the Embassy this morning. On the occasion, Ambassador Shrestha expressed thanks to Sanofi for supporting the earthquake victims.

As of 15 October 2015, a total sum of BDT 4,79,20,628.00 (Bangladesh Taka Four Crores Seventy-nine Lakhs Twenty Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty-Eight) has been collected in the Embassy's Special Relief Account. Of this, a sum of Four Crore Taka was transferred to the Prime Minister Disaster Relief Fund of Nepal on 7 June 2015.
