



Press Release

The Third Nepal-Bangladesh Commerce Secretary Level Meeting was held in Dhaka from 10-11 May 2016. The meeting discussed the overall gamut of trade and commercial relations between Nepal and Bangladesh, and agreed to move forward in enhancing market access, trade facilitation and connectivity between the two countries. An MoU between Nepal Bureau of Standards and Metrology, and Bangladesh Standards and Testing Institution was signed at the conclusion of the meeting. The Nepalese delegation was led by Mr. Naindra Prasad Upadhaya, Secretary, Ministry of Commerce, and the Bangladeshi delegation was led by Mr. Hedayetullah Al Mamoon, ndc, Senior Secretary, Ministry of Commerce.

On 11 May 2016, Commerce Secretary Mr. Upadhaya called on Hon'ble Commerce Minister of Bangladesh, His Excellency Tofail Ahmed at his office in Bangladesh Secretariat. Matters pertaining to bilateral relations particularly in trade and commerce were discussed during the meeting. Mr. Prakash Kumar Suvedi, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Mr. Sushil K Lamsal, CDA, Embassy of Nepal, Dhaka were present during the meeting.

The next Commerce Secretary Level Meeting will be held in Kathmandu. The date of the meeting will be communicated through diplomatic channels.
