As a mark of solidarity and support for the victims of the recent natural disasters in various parts of Nepal, the expatriate Nepali professionals in Bangladesh have contributed a sum equivalent to Rs. 2,14,786.46 (Rupees Two hundred and fourteen thousand seven hundred and eighty-six and forty six paisa only) to the Prime Minister's Disaster Relief Fund.



On behalf of the Nepali community, Mr. Binod Shrestha handed over the financial assistance to His Excellency Mr. H. K. Shrestha, Ambassador of Nepal to Bangladesh, at a function organized at the Embassy of Nepal in Dhaka to celebrate the Teej festival on 27 August 2014. During the occasion, H. E. Mr. Shrestha expressed his deep gratitude and appreciation to the community for reaching out to the victims of the disasters with alacrity.

Similarly, the diplomatic officials of the Embassy of Nepal in Dhaka contributed an amount equivalent to Rupees 27,887.74 (Rupees Twenty seven thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven and seventy four paisa only) as relief assistance for those affected by the disasters. Thus, a total amount equivalent to Rupees 2,42,674.20 (Rupees Two hundred and forty-two thousand six hundred and seventy-four and twenty paisa) was remitted to the Prime Minister's Disaster Relief Fund today.
